the dramatic events of the aeneid have been adapted into dramatic form that is contemporary blank verse by award winning poet h r coursen plays drama

this book demonstrates the ways in which virgil's are poems that heaney lived with long and dreamily especially the

descent into the underworld in aeneid vi it shows that in his original english poems as well as his translations from latin heaney conjures and transforms familiar virgilian motifs the rhythm pace and musicality of virgil s hexameters can be heard in heaney s pastoral eclogues and sonnet sequences and virgil s life and times as well as his poetry contribute to the shaping of heaney s prose poetics in dialogue with virgil as well as other classical and modern poets heaney develops his notion of the redress of poetry the counterbalance that poetry can offer against historical tragedy suffering and loss the book explores heaney s intensely productive thirty year dialogue with virgil beginning with his translation of the golden bough in the 1980s and extending through several major volumes including seeing things the midnight verdict electric light district and circle the riverbank field human chain and the posthumously published translation of aeneid book vi

transcending traditional studies of single translations or particular translation traditions in isolation this is the first volume to offer a critical overview of virgil s influence on later literature through the translation history of his poems from the early modern period to the present day and throughout europe and beyond

this element shows classical translation as inherently creative in practice with new approaches shaping dialogue and genres

this comparative study investigates the epic lineage that can be traced back from derek walcott s omeros and ezra pound s cantos through dante s divina commedia to the epic poems of virgil and homer and identifies and discusses in detail a number of recurrent key topoi a fresh definition of the concept of genre is worked out and presented based on readings of homer the study reads pound s and walcott s poetics in the light of roman jakobson s notions of metonymy and metaphor placing their long poems at the respective opposite ends of their language poles although there has already been an intermittent critical focus on the classical and dantean antecedents of walcott s poetry the present study is the first to bring together the whole range of epic intertextualities underlying omeros and the first to read this caribbean masterpiece in the context of pound s achievement book jacket
