for the first time the 92 metre frieze of the voortrekker monument in pretoria one of the largest historical narratives in marble has been made the subject of a book the pictorial narrative of the boer pioneers who conquered south africa s interior during the great trek 1835 52 represents a crucial period of south africa s past conceptualising the frieze both reflected on and contributed to the country s socio political debates in the
