Being almost addicted to one therapy as a result of my analytic training and experience I at first did REAT only with individual clients and found this pioneering form of CBT considerably more effective than the other therapies with which I had experimented by 1957. However I realized that REAT could be taught to large numbers of persons through self help books and articles and that REAT oriented writings could not only prove valuable to the general public but that they could also be successfully employed to hasten and intensify the therapy of my
